

**Keep Australia Beautiful  
Clean Beaches Awards  
Western Australia**

Between 1997 and 2001 KAB WA ran Perth's Best Beaches competition. The winner for 2001 was Trigg Beach (The City of Stirling)

Between 2002 and 2006 Surf Life Saving WA ran the WA's Best Beach Competition. The winner for 2006 for WA's Best Beach was 'City Beach' (Town of Cambridge)

Launching in Summer 2007/2008, KAB WA and Surf Life Saving WA will be partnering to coordinate the WA Clean Beaches Awards, proudly supported by the Water Corporation.

The program will launch in September 2007. Judging will take place and winners will be announced in February 2008. The State winner goes on to represent Western Australia at the Australian Clean Beaches Awards.

The Western Australian competition will be open to all beaches in WA and any group can nominate a beach (for example community groups, schools, local Councils, tourism associations, businesses, surf life saving clubs etc)

There will be one overall winner of the WA Cleanest Beach Award and five Outstanding Accomplishment Awards:

- Friendly Beach Award
- Community Action Award
- Protection of the Environment Award
- Natural Resource Management Award
- Litter Prevention Award

Finalists will be selected by judges and an awards ceremony will be held in February 2008 to announce winners.
