**Yeppoon Main Beach, QLD, wins Community Partnership Award at  
the Australian Clean Beaches Awards for 2009/2010**

Yeppoon Main Beach in QLD has won the Community Action & Partnerships category at the annual Keep Australia Beautiful, Australian Clean Beaches Awards, held in Manly last night.

Yeppoon Main Beach, represented by Trevor Delelände of Rockhampton Regional Council, was announced the category winner for the Community Action and Partnerships award. According to Australian Clean Beaches Judge, David Moy, Yeppoon Main Beach was a deserving winner of this category.

“Excellent partnerships have been realised between a number of community groups and Council and both the Keppel Bay Sailing Club and the Yeppoon Main Beach SLS Club are actively involved in partnerships with the Rockhampton Regional Council. There is also a partnership with the local Indigenous and a very active partnership with the Great Barrier Reef Marine Park Authority.”

Yeppoon Main Beach also went on to receive a Distinction in the category of Environmental Protection and Innovation, sponsored by Coastal Watch.

“Yeppoon Main beach has been commended for protecting local wildlife such as bats and crocodiles, and implementing other environment initiatives like gross pollutant traps to reduce sediment loads to the beach, weed management programs and indigenous plant propagation”, said David Moy.

In attendance at last night's awards was the Minister for Climate Change, Energy Efficiency and Water, Penny Wong, and local surfer and seven times world champion, Layne Beachley.

Senator Wong commended the winners, “I congratulate the dedicated community members on their commitment in taking steps to improve their local community's environment.”

South Port beach in Noarlunga, SA, was named Overall winner, taking out the title of Australia's Cleanest Beach for 2009/2010.

Through the Australian Clean Beaches Awards, Keep Australia Beautiful is able to recognise local community and individual efforts that are helping beach communities to become environmentally, economically and socially sustainable.
