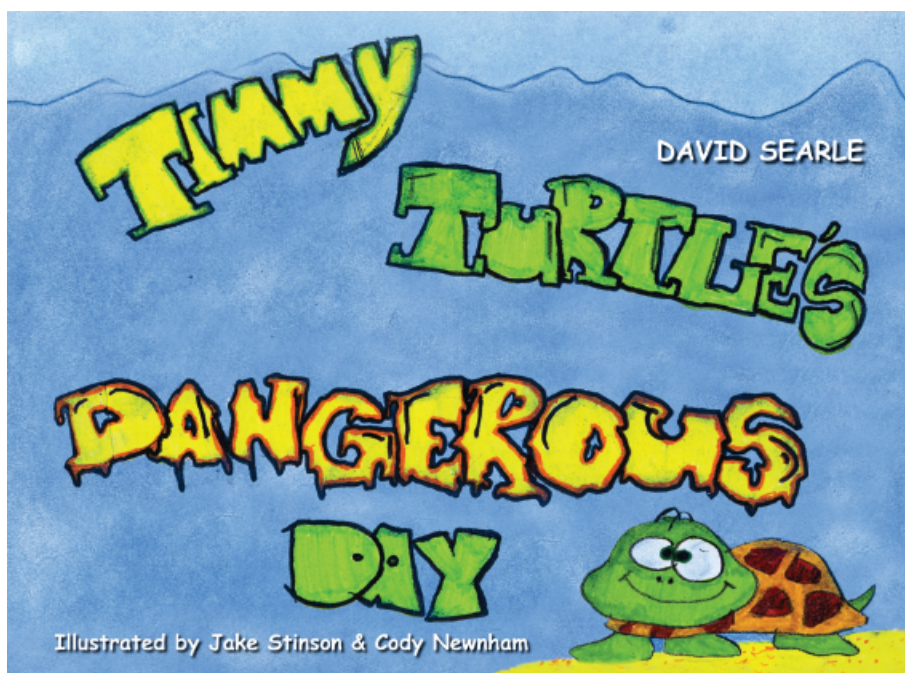


Timmy Turtle's Dangerous Day
