Community Action and Partnership

The Community Action and Partnership Award recognises achievement in community beautification, presentation, health and well-being and pride. It also recognizes partnerships between government, business, industry and local community networks.

The award measures planning, action, impact and collaboration of projects related to community action and partnership.

This year the Community Action and Partnership Award is given to the Redland City Council for demonstrating leadership and achievement in programs that have brought together partnership between the Council, local landowners, community groups and residents.

One of the notable programs of the Redland City Council is the IndigiScapes Environmental Education Center, an environmental resources center for the local community and a popular place for people to visit and relax. IndigiScapes aims to create advocacy in the community through effective engagement and education opportunities.

The Redland City Council has also engaged the community in habitat protection and wildlife programs. To date approximately 850 landholders are participating in the Council's habitat protection program and close to 1745 Ha. are under agreement. The Council likewise provide several programs and supports different organizations in raising community awareness of koalas.
