
Port wins state eco city title

PORT Adelaide Enfield Council has been named South Australia's most sustainable city because of its environmentally friendly mix of projects.

KESAB nominated the district for this year's national Keep Australia Beautiful Sustainable Cities awards to highlight the work of communities to reduce their impact on the local environment.

Executive director John Phillips said the City of Port Adelaide Enfield was able to bring about extensive change through its environmentally focused projects, despite being a working port and a manufacturing and transport hub.

The Port River Dolphin Sanctuary, Semaphore redevelopment, illegal dumping management trial and solar projects were among the initiatives singled out.
